

To the Immigration Minister

Australia is an important member of the global community and must share responsibility to help people escaping war and persecution. By working together we can ensure these people are cared for and provided protection.

I call on you to:

- Settle least 30,000 people escaping war and persecution in Australia each year, prioritising those selected by the UN refugee agency.
- Prioritise people escaping war and persecution in other migration programs (skilled migration program, student and family reunion visas etc)

After World War II the world's governments agreed to work together to save millions of lives. We can do it again.

Record numbers of people are escaping war and persecution and seeking protection in other countries.

The leaders of the world's governments have agreed to work together to find better ways to protect these people seeking safety. **Australia can be part of the solution by equitably sharing responsibility** for these people and increasing our refugee intake to at least 30,000 people each year.
