I am really concerned with the escalation in unlawful killings, with over 1700 people murdered by unknown assassins and police since you came into office as President on June 30.

I urge you to immediately condemn the extrajudicial executions and other unlawful killings to date and end your 'shoot to kill' policy.

I urge you to establish an independent police complaints commission to conduct a prompt and impartial investigation into any use of force by police in order to bring those responsible to justice through a fair trial process.

I urge you to further ensure the rights to life and health of people who use drugs are respected and protected by guaranteeing their access to health-related information and services on a non-discriminatory basis instead of inciting violence

### Philippines: Stop Encouraging Murder

Since coming into power on 30 June 2016, President Rodrigo Duterte has overseen the unlawful killing of more than 30 people every single day.

President Duterte gave police 'shoot to kill' orders along with complete immunity to hunt down any drug suspects. Even vigilante groups and ordinary citizens are taking this as a green light to commit murder. On 7 August 2016 the president released a 'kill list' of 150 people allegedly associated with drugs. This resulted in terrible violence, bodies on the streets and even deaths in custody.

This anarchy will continue to rise unless we demand that the president immediately stops sanctioning murder.
