I am very concerned for Narges Mohammadi, who in serving a 16-year prison sentence for “founding an illegal group”, “gathering and colluding to commit crimes against national security”, and “spreading propaganda against the system”.

I call on you to:

- Immediately and unconditionally release Narges Mohammadi as she is a prisoner of conscience held solely for her peaceful human rights activism.
- Guarantee that she receives adequate health care by a qualified health professional outside of prison, whilst ensuring ethical medical standards of confidentiality, autonomy, and informed consent.
- Take steps to protect the right to freedom of expression and freedom of assembly within Iran.

Human rights lawyer, Narges Mohammadi, received a 16-year prison sentence following an unfair trial in April 2016, She was already serving a six-year prison sentence from a previous case. Her convictions were based solely on her peaceful human rights work, including campaigning for justice, gender equality, and against the death penalty.

Narges Mohammadi suffers from a serious neurological health condition. While imprisoned, her condition has exacerbated and she needs specialised medical treatment. You can help her today.
