We call on you to:

Immediately end the violence and human rights abuses against the Rohingya people

Ensure free and unimpeded access to Rakhine state to humanitarian actors, the UN, independent journalists and human rights monitors and ensure their security.

In less than 4 weeks, more than 400,000 Rohingya people have fled Myanmar to nearby Bangladesh. There are many reports of killings by the Myanmar military and satellite images suggest that entire villages have been burned. Many are risking their lives by trying to escape in fishing boats. Some are badly injured and with children. We must not let the Myanmar military continue this campaign of violence against the Rohingya people.
