

Dear Minister/Your Excellency,

On the 31st January 2018, the court ruled that Taner Kılıç would be released, following eight months in jail.

However, just as Taner's family waited for him to walk out of jail, he was re-arrested. There is no new evidence against him, and treating him and his family in this manner is not only unjust – it is cruel.

Please make sure the court's order to release Taner is respected, and that he is freed immediately.

Taner Kılıç, Chair of Amnesty International Turkey, was thrown into prison in June 2017, the latest effort to silence critics and crackdown on freedoms in Turkey.

Taner was granted conditional release on 31 January, however, just as Taner's family waited for him to walk out of jail, he was re-arrested. His wife and daughters never got the chance to welcome him home.

Tell Turkey to immediately release Taner Kılıç, stop persecuting these rights defenders, and drop the charges against them.
