I call on you to immediately and unconditionally release human rights defender Tep Vanny, drop all charges against her and end all criminal investigations against her.

Tep Vanny is a housing rights activist who has defended her community in central Phnom Penh from forced evictions. She has been beaten, harassed, arrested, and imprisoned by the Cambodian authorities.

She is a human rights defender and prisoner of conscience, detained on baseless charges for her peaceful activism, and she deserves to be free and with her family.

Tep Vanny is housing rights activist, and for almost 10 years she has been defending families forcibly evicted from their homes in central Phnom Penh.

She is in jail as a result of her participation in a peaceful protest, and her determination to defend the rights of others.

Tell Cambodian Prime Minister Hun Sen to immediately and unconditionally release Tep Vanny.
